

EYES

FOREIGN BODIES/SCRATCHES- Muzzle the dog before examining, as eye injuries can be very painful. If the dog is squinting but there is no visible bleeding or foreign body, apply cool compress and CALL VET. If bleeding, apply pressure (moisten material being used to apply pressure or use K-Y jelly to keep eye moist and CALL VET. If a foreign body is in the eye-DO NOT REMOVE IT- CALL VET.

PROPTOSED EYE- Apply moistened gauze to eye and CALL VET. Keep the dog quiet. Some breeds are predisposed to this problem, but it can happen to any dog.

BLEEDING IN THE EYE- CALL VET.
